

## GILLAMS SPRING CLEAN UP POLICY



**Spring Clean – up for residents properties in the Town of Gillams will take place on Wednesday, May 21, 2014 ending Monday, May 26, 2014 with pick – up beginning on Tuesday, May 27, 2014.**

### ***SPRING CLEANUP POLICY***

- ❖ **Clean up will take place only during the date outlined.**
- ❖ **Garbage must be out by 8:00a.m. on the morning of pick-up.**
- ❖ **All materials should be bagged and/or bundled along the road reserves for each access.**
- ❖ **The maximum weight is 40lbs. This does not apply to furniture.**
- ❖ **There will be absolutely no pick up of the following:**
  - **Trees or tree limbs, shrubs, grass, sand, gravel, or rocks.**
  - **Hazardous waste materials such as paint cans, thinners, propane tanks, etc.**
  - **Shingles, construction waste, renovations waste, or concrete waste.**
  - **Appliances containing Freon. Appliances that originally contained Freon must have a sticker stating that the Freon has been properly removed by a qualified person or it will not be picked up.**
  - **No Electronics**
  - **Tires. Please note that tires may be brought to the place of purchase for proper disposal.**
- ❖ **Residents are asked to adopt a street and ensure clean up is completed all year.**
- ❖ **Residents will be encouraged to remove and/or repair structures such as; fences, sheds. Residents will also be asked to groom properties and plant flowers in an effort to make our community cleanest and most appealing in Newfoundland.**
- ❖ **All dates and regulations listed above will be strictly adhered to.**
