**2012 ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN-UP**  
**MAY 2(Wednesday) – MAY 8 (Tuesday)**  
**PICK UP MAY 9**

Please note: Do not put out household garbage until the normal garbage day (May 8th), and do not put out any clean-up items in boxes until the clean-up day (May 9th) because of rain or animals.

May exceed more than one day depending on amount of garbage.

(Once your garbage is picked up collectors will not be returning to that area)

The Annual clean up period will be carried out as follows:

The following items will be collected.

**WHAT'S ACCEPTED**

- Household Appliances (Stoves, Hot water tanks, etc). Note: Any item such as refrigerators or air conditioners must be labeled AODS free. Anything not properly labeled will not be accepted.
- Household furniture (sofa, chairs, box springs 7 mattresses, etc)
- Lawn furniture
- Toys (bikes, etc)
- Small automotive parts (rims, etc.)
- Garden items (branches and grass cutting)

**WHAT'S NOT ACCEPTED**

- Wood (Pallets/lumber/braches)
- Hazardous, explosive or toxic waste
- Commercial or business waste
- Liquid waste
- Tires- Residents are advised that under the Provincial Governments used Tire Recycling Program tires cannot be disposed of at the Landfill.
- Loose Materials
- Automotive parts exceeding 35kg. In aggregate weight.
- Construction waste such as gyproc, shingles, lumber, concrete. Etc

Residents are reminded that Section 17 & 23 of the Waste Material Disposal Act prohibits dumping in all areas of Town. Violators will be prosecuted to the full extend of the law. Your co-operation is requested in helping keep our town clean and beautiful.

**To keep the town clean and tidy please do not start clean up until the date specified (May 02,2012). Garbage other than household items will not be pick up until May 9<sup>th</sup>.**
