



## The Town of Gillams, NL

### **Regulation # GSn1: Clearing of Snow on Municipal Roads and/or other Public Access Areas**

Whereas Section 163(3) of the HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT [RSNL1990 CHAPTER H-3]

Whereas Section 11(1) of CHAPTER W12 of an ACT RESPECTING PUBLIC WORKS, SERVICES and TRANSPORTATION

#### 1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1. Municipal Roadway includes a common and public street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge viaduct or trestle designed and intended for, or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles
- 1.2. Municipal water and drain areas include rivers, streams, ditches and culverts
- 1.3. Public Right-of-Ways are areas of public access and use
- 1.4. Effective dates for snow clearing will vary depending on the weather, but includes the timeline between the first and last clearable snowfall or ice formation
- 1.5. Snow and Ice clearing services include snow and ice removal, and/or the application of salt and/or sand

#### 2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 2.1. In the explicit interest of town safety
  - 2.1.1. No vehicle shall be parked on any municipal roadways or other public right-of-ways during the snow clearing season
  - 2.1.2. No person shall deposit or relocate, or cause to be deposited or relocated, any snow or ice, or any other matter or thing, on any portion of any municipal roadway, parking area, walkway, waterway, or drainage area within the territorial limits of the municipality of Gillams, NL.
- 2.2. The town of Gillams will not accept any responsibility for damages to personal property during snow clearing and/or ice control operations that occur within 25 ft. from the roadway center.
- 2.3. The town of Gillams does not provide snow and/or ice clearing, or other unauthorized services to private property

#### 3. ENFORCEMENT

- 3.1. The town of Gillams reserves the right to contact provincial authorities regarding any violation of the abovementioned provisions, and also any known violation with respect to applicable provincial acts governing areas outside town control, but within town limits.

#### 4. IMPLEMENTATION

- 4.1. This regulation is effective October 1, 2009

5. VALIDITY

5.1. If a court declares any provision, or any part of a provision, in this regulation to be invalid, then Council will modify the regulation accordingly.

5.2. The town welcomes any suggested modifications to this regulation for the betterment of the town
